This fund may be used to support a graduate student associateship or fellowship in Extension. Applicants will be considered from graduate programs in the following priority order: Agricultural and Extension Education (specialization in Extension Education), Agricultural Economics, and Human Ecology. Current Extension faculty or staff who desire to complete a graduate degree or a study leave from their position are encouraged to apply.

1. The funds available under this endowment may be used for an associateship or fellowship stipend.
2. The Director of Extension with the Chair of the Department of Human and Community Resource Development is responsible for administering the funds.
3. Applications should be submitted to the Chair of the Agricultural and Extension Education (AEE) Graduate Studies Committee. Applications are available on-line at: (http://hcrd.ag.ohio-state.edu/ag_education/graduate_scholarships.html).
4. Applications should be submitted by March 1, 2012.
5. Applicants may be asked to interview with a selection committee. Recipients may also be asked to meet with the donor, Lois Hungate, if it can be arranged.
